


CROSSROADS (6th - 8th Grade)

Summer 2020: Field Trip Activity Schedule

SLIME WORKS: In addition to each week being filled with some slimy fun, there will also be a weekly theme relating to the slime we are making or learning about. So we will have space and glow in the dark activities during Galaxy Slime Week, we will look into marine life during Fishbowl Slime Week, and we will do lots of activities that have to do with going fast during Speed Slime Week. Plus continuing with the Slime Works theme, each week during opening session (and beyond) campers will learn how to get out of "sticky" life situations as they learn what the Bible has to say about things like lying, gossip, bullying, peer pressure, cheating, and more!



Session 1 (6/1 - 6/5): Fishbowl Slime (Marine Life)

We are kicking off camp with an incredible first week! First up, an exciting trip to the **Lift Adventure Park at Hudson's SunWest Park**. While there, campers may feel like a fish as they enjoy some beach fun at a waterfront facility made from the former SunWest Mines and a session on the inflatable on-the-water adventure park. And campers will enjoy a trip to either **AMC Classic or AMC Woodlands 20** to see a movie. Plus students will head to **Swim @ Highland Family Aquatics Center**, the premier Pinellas county swimming pool featuring a play / splash area, 4+ water slides, and so much more!

Session 2 (6/8 - 6/12): Mystery Slime (Mystery & Adventure)

Taking the mystery theme to one of its finest (and funniest) forms, students will travel to **Sleuth's Mystery Dinner Theater** in Orlando for a private matinee show of their interactive mystery theater experience (with lots of food of course). And campers will experience an all new exciting adventure, velcro **Archery Tag (On Site)**. The fun is sure to be **RIGHT ON TARGET!** Plus campers will also enjoy a swimming and beach trip to the always beautiful **Honeymoon Island** in Dunedin.



Session 3 (6/15 - 6/19): VBS WEEK

As middle schoolers, campers are unfortunately too old to attend VBS. So what does that mean? A different schedule and... **4 field trips!** Campers will enjoy a trip to **Dave & Buster's Tampa** with unlimited games galore and a tasty buffet lunch that's sure to leave even a middle schooler's belly full. Campers are also headed to **Laser Ops**. Not just standard laser tag, Laser Ops is a state-of-the-art family entertainment center with Tactical Laser Tag and more. Plus campers will get their soak on twice this week with trips to **Splash Harbour Water Park** (featuring several slides and a lazy river) and **Fred Howard Park Beach**.

Session 4 (6/22 - 6/26): Wild About Slime (Animals)

This is definitely a week you won't want to miss! It features a trip for students to see and interact with giraffes, lemurs, and more at Dade City's **Giraffe Ranch**. At this 47 acre ranch, students will board an oversized jeep and see, feed, and interact with animals up close and in their natural environment. Campers will also paint a wildlife masterpiece when **I Heart Corky Art (On Site)** comes to camp. Their pros will help our campers create their own wildlife canvas painting. Plus campers will also get to swim, play in the sand and waves, and blend in with the local wildlife at **Sunset Beach** in Tarpon Springs.



Session 5 (6/29 - 7/2): Star Spangled Slime (America)

Students can attend this 4 day week for just \$119! Campers will feel like they're living the American dream as they enjoy the numerous slides, water rides, wave pool, lazy river, and more at the **BRAND NEW Island H2O Live @ Orlando's Margaritaville Resort**. Plus campers will celebrate America's favorite pastime as they head to Tropicana Field to see our hometown favorites take on the Los Angeles Angels at a **Tampa Bay Rays Game**.

Session 6 (7/6 - 7/10): Galaxy Slime (Space / Glow in the Dark Fun)

One of the biggest trips of the summer is go for launch. Students blast off to **Kennedy Space Center** for a trip they will likely never forget. They will ride the shuttle launch experience, see actual rockets and the space shuttle Atlantis, touch a moon rock, and maybe even hear from a real astronaut. Campers will also enjoy a fun day of **Glow-In-The-Dark Gaga Ball and Glow-In-The-Dark Dodgeball (On Site)**. So cool! And students will head to **Anclote River State Park Beach** for another great day of swimming, water play, and beach fun.



Session 7 (7/13 - 7/17): Unicorn Slime (Dreams & Imagination)

What an incredible week! First, get ready for the thrill of a lifetime (and a little learning too) with **iFly Tampa - Indoor Skydiving and STEM Experience**. Students will not only get to personally skydive (indoors of course) but they will learn about momentum, wind and air velocity, and more through discussion, demonstration, and hands-on experiments. Then cool off with one more trip to the **Highland Family Aquatics Center** and another chance to swim, soak up the rays, and ride those water slides. And this week campers will get to take the stage and show off their talents at the annual **Camp CUBBER's Got Talent Show (On Site)**.



Session 8 (7/20 - 7/24): Speed Slime (Going Fast!)

We are really excited about Session 8! With the state's best wave pool, plus Castaway Creek, Gangplank Falls, the Crush N' Gusher, and more, you won't want to miss this trip to **Disney's Typhoon Lagoon**. While there if you're brave enough, race down the one and only Humunga Kowabunga water slide. Campers will also head to **Game Time** in Tampa, FL to enjoy one of the areas coolest arcades with unlimited video games and virtual arcade racing that is simply amazing! Campers will also be dashing, relaying, and running as fast as they can in the **Camp CUBBER Olympic Field Day (On Site)**.



Session 9 (7/27 - 7/31): Enough with the Slime (Just Plain Fun!)

Enough slime, this week will be JUST PLAIN FUN! First an unforgettable trip to **Universal Studios Orlando** where students can hang with Gru on Despicable Me: Minion Mayhem, blast some aliens on Men in Black: Alien Attack, ride the thrilling Hollywood Rip Ride Rockit, feel the magical rush of Harry Potter and the Escape from Gringotts, and more. Campers will also enjoy **Adventure Games / Inflatables (On Site)** that will feature bungee trampolines, a rock climbing wall, and more! And what better way to end the summer than with some fun in the sun as students swim and hang with friends at **Clearwater Beach**. Due to limited capacity, Session 9 is only available to campers signed up for **7 or more total sessions** or who are enrolled in Stars & Comets for the 2020 - 2021 school year.
