### DREAM BIG: What Do I Dream to Be?

*This summer's theme will focus on the question that so many kids ask - What do I want to be when I grow up? Each week will have activities and field trips themed around a few potential dream jobs for the future-things like marine biologist, scientist/engineer, actor/director, animal researcher, and more!*



#### Session 1 (6/3 - 6/7): Dream Big! (Intro)

Maybe Session 1 should've been called Session Fun. Campers will enjoy a trip to **Dave & Buster's Tampa** with unlimited games galore and a tasty buffet lunch that's sure to leave even a middle schooler's belly full. Plus campers will let their inner American Ninja Warrior out as they take on the obstacles at **Skyzone**. They will bounce, climb, and soar like never before. And campers will participate in a fun **Blacklight Dodgeball Tournament** (On Site) provided by Dodgeball 2 U.

#### Session 2 (6/10 - 6/14): VBS Week

As middle schoolers, campers are now too old to attend VBS. What does that mean? A bit of a different schedule and a week with... 4 field trips! Campers will **Swim @ Highland Family Aquatics Center**, the premier Pinellas county swimming pool featuring a play / splash area, 4+ water slides, and more! They'll go see our hometown favorites take on the Oakland A's at a **Tampa Bay Rays Game**. Then campers will enjoy going to **See a Movie @ AMC Classic Palm Harbor**. And campers will head to **Sun West Park** in Hudson, FL which features the Lift Adventure Aqua Park with an on-water inflatable obstacle course. What a week!



#### Session 3 (6/17 - 6/21): Scientist / Engineer

Session 3 is going to be an exciting one! Campers are headed to **Laser Ops**. This is going to be an amazing week! Campers will kick the week off with a show from the **Menestrelli Circus Dogs Show** (On Site).
